

5. Motions for summary judgment must be heard not later than 30 days before the trial date.

6. On or before the above-specified discovery completion date, depositions must be concluded, although not necessarily transcribed, and responses to written and production discovery requests must be due.

7. Not later than 7 days before the commencement of trial, all parties shall:

a. File and exchange trial briefs (trial briefs exceeding 15 pages must include a table of contents and table of authorities);

b. File and exchange witness lists, including a brief summary of the anticipated testimony from each witness;

c. Exchange, but not file, copies of all exhibits. Exhibits are to be premarked for identification, using numbers for plaintiff's exhibits and letters for defendant's exhibits. The exhibits should be placed in a binder with an appropriate identification tab.

8. At the commencement of trial, the parties shall be prepared to stipulate into evidence all exhibits as to which there is no objection.

9. The parties shall ensure that there is an additional copy for the judge's use of each exhibit entered into evidence.
