

**NOTICE OF CHANGE IN THE ISSUANCE  
OF SUMMONS IN ADVERSARY PROCEEDINGS  
TO PROVIDE FOR NOTICE OF DISPUTE  
RESOLUTION ALTERNATIVES**

This change is in addition to and in conjunction with the November 1, 2001, change in Clerk's Office procedure regarding the issuance of summons in adversary proceedings and is intended to implement Del. Bankr. LR 9019-1 to 9019-6.

As of March 7, 2002, a party or attorney filing a complaint or third party complaint is required to also serve a Notice of Dispute Resolution Alternatives (available on the Court's website) along with the summons and notice of pretrial conference in an adversary proceeding and provide a certificate of service.
