

**HON. THOMAS L. AMBRO FELLOWSHIP
CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF SUMMER SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT**

This year, the Delaware Bankruptcy American Inn of Court is again awarding a \$5,000 stipend for a summer internship with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware. The candidate must apply for a eight-week summer internship rotating among each of the Judges of the Delaware Bankruptcy Court. The Recipient will be accountable to the Chief Judge (or his chambers designee) for scheduling, hours, etc.

The criteria for the successful candidate should include:

- 1) an interest in practicing law in Delaware;
- 2) a sense of ethics and high moral character;
- 3) intelligent, honest and hard working;
- 4) a pleasant personality and ability to work independently or as part of a team; and
- 5) an interest in commercial or bankruptcy law.

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants who meet the selection criteria should send a letter of interest with their resume to:

Letters of interest and resumes should be sent no later than February 20, 2009.

The Judges of the Delaware Bankruptcy Court shall select the successful candidate at in their sole discretion. Top applicants may be required to interview for the position from mid-February to early March. The Recipient will be notified by the end of March.

Half of the stipend amount will be provided to the recipient at an awards ceremony held in May. The remaining amounts will be paid at the end of the fellowship.
