Justice Joseph T. Walsh is Of Counsel to McCarter & English, LLP. His practice focuses on mediation, arbitration and counseling in connection with Delaware corporate and business law matters. He received his B.A. with honors from LaSalle College, Philadelphia, in June, 1952 and received L.L.B. degree from Georgetown University Law School in September, 1954. He served three years on active duty as a member of the Judge Advocate General's School of the United States Army and is a graduate of Judge Advocate General's School at the University of Virginia, 1956.
