ORDER FOR SCHEDULING CONFERENCE *

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A telephonic scheduling conference arranged through CourtCall shall be held on _____, 20__ at ____m.
2. Prior to the telephone conference, counsel shall confer pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 7026(f) and shall submit a joint discovery plan to the Court not later than three (3) business days prior to the conference. The discovery plan shall conform to the enclosed form of scheduling order. Initial disclosures pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 7026(a)(1) need not be made prior to the teleconference with the Court.
3. At the teleconference with the Court, all parties shall be represented by counsel who shall have full authority to bind their clients in all pretrial matters.
4. If any party enters an appearance after the date of this order and before the teleconference set by this order, counsel for plaintiff shall notify the newly appearing party of the teleconference and forward to that party a copy of this Order.
5. The parties shall advise the Court immediately if this matter has been settled or terminated so that the scheduled teleconference may be cancelled.
