ORDERED, that any debtor seeking a discharge under 11 USC Section 1328(i) shall file a Notice and Motion for Discharge setting forth the factors supporting the discharge request; and it is further


ORDERED, that the Motion shall include a fully executed Local Form 104 as appropriately modified, and it is further

ORDERED, that the Motion shall initially be scheduled for hearing on the Chapter 13 Trustee's Confirmation calendar, and if unopposed upon the filing of a Certificate of No Response by counsel relief may be granted without further hearing and a discharge may be issued on the Official Form evidencing Section 1328(i). Should a response be filed to the Motion, a hearing shall be scheduled on the Court's Special Chapter 13 Calendar, and it is further

ORDERED, that after the discharge under Section 1328(i) is entered by the Court, the Chapter 13 Trustee shall file a final report and the case may be closed.
