ORDER AMENDING PARAGRAPH 7.a OF SIXTH AMENDED ORDER GOVERNING THE CONDUCT OF HEARINGS DUE TO CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) AND RECONSITUTING OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2021, Chief Judge Colm F. Connolly, United States

District Court for the District of Delaware entered a Revised Standing Order

Regarding Use of Face Mask/Coverings in Public Areas of the District and

Bankruptcy Courts;

NOW THEREFORE, it is **HEREBY ORDERED** that:

- Paragraph 7.a. of the Sixth Amended Order Governing the Conduct of
 Hearings Due to Coronavirus Disease 2019 (Covid-19) and
 Reconstituting Operations is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the
 following:
 - a. Persons who have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 are no longer required to wear a mask in the public areas of the Bankruptcy Court (lobby, corridors, elevators, restrooms, etc.). The Revised Standing Order re Use of Face Mask/Coverings in Public Areas of the District and Bankruptcy Courts issued July 16, 2020 is no longer in effect in the Bankruptcy Court to the extent inconsistent herewith.

 All other provisions of the Sixth Amended Order Governing the Conduct of Hearings Due to Coronavirus Disease 2019 (Covid-19) and Reconstituting Operations remain in effect.
