GENERAL ORDER

Whereas, a creditor pursuant to 11 USC Section 342 (e) in a case under Chapter 7 or 13 may file with the Court a notice of address to be used to provide notice in such case to such creditor, and


Whereas, an entity pursuant to 11 USC Section 342 (f) in all cases pending under Chapter 7 and 13 may file with any bankruptcy court a notice of address to be used by all the bankruptcy courts or by particular bankruptcy courts to provide notice to such entity, and

Whereas, the Court has determined that the most efficient and expeditious implementation of these provisions would be to utilize the procedures and services provided by the National Creditor Registration Service, it is

Ordered that any creditor or entity that chooses to file such notice pursuant to the above-referenced sections of the United States Code shall, in lieu of filing a notice with the Court, register with the National Creditor Registration Service on such forms as are provided on its website at ~~www.ncsuscourts.com~~ www.ncrsuscourts.com and such registration shall fulfill the requirements of 11 USC Sections 342 (e) and (f).
