implementation of these provisions would be to utilize the procedures and services provided by

the National Creditor Registration Service, it is

Ordered that any creditor or entity that chooses to file such notice pursuant to the above-

referenced sections of the United States Code shall, in lieu of filing a notice with the Court,

register with the National Creditor Registration Service on such forms as are provided on its

website at www.ncsuscourts.com www.ncrsuscourts.com and such registration shall fulfill the

requirements of 11 USC Sections 342 (e) and (f).
