Rule 3011-1 Deposit or Release of Funds Paid into the Registry of the Court.

- (a) <u>Deposit of Funds</u>. Funds may only be deposited into the Registry of Court upon motion specifying the amount to be deposited and the reason for the deposit. If the deposit is for unclaimed distributions, then the movant must also specify the list of payees, including the last four digits of each payee's taxpayer identification number (which may be redacted under Local Rule 9037-1(b)), each payee's last known address, the amount due to each payee and why the distributions did not occur to the payees.
- (b) <u>Application for Withdrawal of Funds</u>. An application for the withdrawal of funds paid into the Registry of the Court must conform to Local Form 127. The applicant must redact confidential information from the publicly-filed application and any exhibit, and deliver an unredacted copy of the application and exhibit to the Clerk's Office in a sealed envelope.
