## Rule 3022-1 Final Decree in Chapter 11 Cases.

- (a) <u>Motion for Final Decree</u>. A motion for final decree must include a proposed final decree order that orders the closing of the case and identifies in the caption and in the body of the order the case name and case number of each case to be closed under the order.
  - (i) <u>Serving the Motion</u>. The motion must be served on the parties listed in Local Rule 2002-1(b) at least 21 days before the hearing.
  - (ii) <u>Final Report</u>. The debtor or trustee must file a final report and account at least 14 days before the hearing on the motion.
- (b) <u>Individual Debtor's Discharge</u>. To obtain a discharge, an individual debtor who has completed plan payments must file a request for a discharge substantially conforming to Local Form 104A.
