SECOND AMENDED ORDER - EMERGENCY CLERK'S OFFICE
PROCEDURES

The Bankruptcy Court is continuing to monitor the outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and given the risk of transmission and the potentially serious consequences, the Bankruptcy Court has implemented procedures to protect Court personnel and the public from the spread of disease. Effective March 17, 2021, the following procedures for Clerk's Office operations will be implemented:

- The Intake Counter of the Clerk's Office will open to the public Monday through Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- Emergency bankruptcy petitions for individuals may also be filed electronically by accessing the link on the Court's website. Documents may be delivered to the court through the drop boxes located in the lobby of the courthouse.
- All remote hearings going forward will be conducted entirely over Zoom and will require all participants to register in advance. The Zoom registration can be found on the hearing agenda after filing. CourtCall will no longer be used to dial in unless otherwise specified by chambers. Please visit the Court's website for specific chambers procedures.
